- 1) H.R. 3942** - To redesignate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 7 Commercial Boulevard in Middletown, Rhode Island, as the "Rhode Island Veterans Post Office Building" (Rep. Kennedy {RI} - Government Reform).
- 2) H.Res. 399** - Honoring the life and legacy of Melvin Jones and recognizing the contributions of Lions Clubs International (Rep. Kennedy {MN} - Government Reform).
- 3) H.Res. 578** - Supporting the goals and ideals of Financial Literacy Month (Rep. Biggert - Government Reform).

- 2) H.Con.Res. 376** - Authorizing the use of the Capitol Grounds for the Greater Washington Soap Box Derby (Rep. Hoyer - Transportation & Infrastructure).
- 3) S. 2043** - To designate a Federal building in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, as the "Ronald Reagan Federal Building" (Sen. Specter - Transportation & Infrastructure).
- 4) H.Con.Res. 388** - Authorizing the use of the Capitol Grounds for the National Peace Officers' Memorial Service (Rep. LaTourette - Transportation & Infrastructure).
- 5) H.R. 3170** - Increased Capital Access for Growing Business Act (Rep. Kelly - Financial Services).
